- **Retirement of Larry Erwin:** after 22 years of dedicated service to Saint Joseph School and Parish, Larry has submitted his resignation. We thank Larry for his many years of service and wish him many years of happy and healthy retirement.
- **Census 15-16:** The parish currently has 1313 registered families for our parish. I believe that this number is not accurate and in order to save money on annual mailings, everyone will receive a new census to complete and return to the Parish Office to update our files. Whether you have been a parishioner for one day or one hundred years, we ask that you kindly fill out this form. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
- **Professional Image:** In order to attempt to bring Saint Joseph Church to a more "professional" image, we have begun to remodel our webpage, reprint our stationery, change our bulletin, our buildings and grounds to present a more orderly, clean and welcoming atmosphere.
- **Local & National Collection:** in order to do away with continuous second collections, we will be asking each family to make an annual donation of \$100 (payable in 3 installments) thereby eliminating any further collections with the exception of Mission Cooperative, Bishop's Annual Appeal, Retired Religious.
